

He stated that he has brought this to the attention of the Election Commission and they are steadfastly trying to look at alternatives and hopefully can come up with the voting machines by the time of the Primary Election. He said that he would be forthcoming with a recommendation as soon as he receives one from the Election Commission.

Mr. George Knight, Council Chairman, reported that the County will extend the deadline for payment of property taxes without penalty, only to the owners of agricultural property who have mistakes in their tax notices. These property owners must take their incorrect notices to the Auditor's office before the February 15 deadline for correction. Their deadline for payment of taxes without a 15 percent penalty will be 45 days from the date corrected and adjusted notices are received. He took that information and added it to the map that was prepared back in December.

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Mr. Cleveland said that he would like for members of the Water Authority to look at each page and tell Council whether or not there are any customers that are not marked on the maps, so that Council will have a basis of determining what they should do with that information.

The Water Authority members present at the meeting said that they would like to be given the map and have a chance to go over it.

Mr. Cleveland said that the Water Authority's members should be given the map. He stated that there is a meeting scheduled for Monday between the County and representatives of the Water Authority. He said that the Water Authority members could come back Monday and let the Council know whether the maps encompasses all the customers or not.

Mr. Jack Roumillat of the Water Authority said that they did not have a whole lot that they could bring up at this point but they appreciated the opportunity of the Council to bring this up to give them their customers back. He said that they always thought that this was an oversight in some part and he is glad that they are getting this resolved. He also said that the maps will show that it is pretty well covered, but the question going through their minds now is the Knightsville area and different other areas that they had lines spread all out now and they get new customers wanting to tie in every week and he thinks that they can give more information at Monday's meeting. They also want to know how Council proposed to serve these customers West of Summerville, the Knightsville area and whatever.

Mr. Handelsman, Chairman of the Planning, Development and Purchasing Committee, stated that there would be a meeting of that Committee on May 31, 1984 at 7:00 P.M. in the Services Building in Summerville.

4. On the motion of Mr. Wall, seconded by Mrs. Lang, Council voted

unanimously to give 2nd Reading to Industrial Bonds for Kores-Nordic Corp.

- 5. On the motion of Mr. Handelsman, seconded by Mrs. Lang, Council voted unanimously to request State Application to the State Aeronautics for Assistance, Dorchester County Airport, Summerville, S.C. in the amount of \$320,948.
- Council Chairman to sign the Contract with Summerville Aviation for lease of existing fixed base operator at the Summerville Aviation for \$100 per month and 2 cents per gallon for gas; Mr. Wall amended the motion to look into the matter further and study it more and place it noted in favor of the amendment, 3 opposed, and 1 abstained. On the motion carried.
- 7. On the motion of Mrs. Lang, seconded by Mr. Edmond Knight, Council voted unanimously to declare a 1958 Chevy Pick-Up Truck from DHEC as surplus equipment and authorize the purchasing agent to dispose of it.

(Chairman Knight said that he wanted to make it clear that this applied to Zoned and Coded Areas only).
- 16. On the motion of Mr. Handelsman, seconded by Mr. Edmond Knight, Council voted unanimously to give 3rd Reading to Consolidated Permit for Manufactured Housing.
- 17. On the motion of Mrs. Lang, seconded by Mr. Handelsman, Council voted 5 in favor and 1 abstained, that the proposed site for the Boat Ramp at the Ashley River be adopted pending the upgrading of Dorchester Road.
- 18. On the motion of Mrs. Lang, seconded by Mr. Edmond Knight, Council voted unanimously to add certain roads to the Official County Road System so they can be maintained. (One is a road in Sprucewood Subdivision near the dumpster site. The others are located in Districts 1, 4 and 7).

Chairman Knight then relinquished the Chair to Vice-Chairman Lang.

19. On the motion of Mr. George Knight, seconded by Mr. Edmond Knight, Council voted unanimously for request by the Upper Dorchester County Rescue Squad to permit the S.C. Highway Department to erect a street sign in Rosinville to be known as Turpentine Avenue. This is being done as part of the annual Turpentine Festival which is held each year so that the Rescue Squad may continue to serve the citizens of Dorchester County and surrounding area.

Mr. George Knight discussed with Council the Court Order that was placed on the Public Works Department several years ago concerning work on private property and the Attorney General's Opinion which followed shortly describing exactly what was private and what was public. This has left a number of driveways, lanes, and avenues to many farmhouses and homes in the Upper part of the County as well as the Lower part of the County unmaintained. A number of these are elderly, disabled, and people of low income. For these people to hire private contractors to maintain these roads is out of the question for economic reasons. To bring a private contractor in to load and unload a motor grader to work such roads, would in all probability, cost no less than \$300. We have a number of farm roads that give access to farmlands and timber lands. These people pay sums of taxes on this raw land and practically the only service not provided by the County to date is some road maintenance work for these people. He suggested that in the future that the Council try to begin maintaining these roads with our present County equipment whenever the equipment is in the area or for a minimum fee (whatever it costs the County to do the work). He said that a figure in line would be \$35.00 per hour for a motor grader. Most of these lanes or short roads would take about 10 or 15 minutes to work; some twice a year. So we are talking about a cost of \$10.00 per year to the owners of these properties.

20. On the motion of Mr. George Knight, seconded by Mr. Waggoner, that the County begin working roads that used to be maintained by the County and now are considered private property for a minimum fee or cost to the County of around \$35.00 per hour; Mr. Handelsman amended the motion to place it in the Public Works Committee and allow them to determine the

legality of it, the cost as proposed and the availability of equipment. Mr. Edmond Knight seconded the amended motion. Council voted unanimously for the amendment.

On the motion of Mr. Reeves, seconded by Mr. Wall, Council voted unanimously to accept the minutes of December 3, 1984 Council meeting.

A Public Hearing was held concerning Street Name Changes. After comments from the public Chairman Knight declared the Public Hearing Closed.
