Vice Chairman Edwards called the meeting to order and Mr. Coke Weeks give the invocation for the public hearing. Vice Chairman Edwards asked if there were any comments from the public. After questions and comments from the public Mr. Handelsman moved to accept 2nd reading of the supplemental budget. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Four in favor. The motion carried. Mr. Edwards closed the public hearing.

Dorchester County Council held a meeting January 7 at 10 A.M. in St. George.

All members were present.

Chairman Waggoner called the meeting to order and Revrend Gleaton gave the invocation.

1. Mr. Handelsman moved to amend that in the minutes of December 17, 1979 in the first paragraph that the words "and the supplemental budget" be removed. Seconded by Mr. Wall. Six in favor. The motion carried.
2. Mr. Edwards moved to accept the minutes as amended. Seconded by Mr. Wall. Six in favor. The motion carried.
3. Mr. Wall moved to accept the minutes of the December 27, 1979 meeting of County Council. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Six in favor. The motion carried.
4. Mr. Wall moved to accept the minutes of the January 3, 1980 meeting of the Legislative & Intergovernmental Affairs Committee. Seconded by Mr. Edwards. Six in favor. The motion carried.

5. Mr. Wall moved to accept low bid for the ambulance from Superior Sales Incorporated in the amount of \$19,532.24. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Four in favor. The motion carried.
6. Mr. Wall moved to pay Colson's Garage for repairs to two(2) garbage trucks in the amount of \$1,944.97. Seconded by Mr. Weeks. Six in favor. The motion carried.
7. Mr. Wall moved to authorize the ordering of Books for the Library from The McNaughton Book Service in the amount of \$3,677.88. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Six in favor. The motion carried.
8. Mr. Wall moved that 1st reading be given to the Encroachment Permit Ordinance and that it be placed in the Legislative & Intergovernmental Affairs Committee. Seconded by Mr. Edwards. Six in favor. The motion carried.
9. Mr. Wall moved to accept 1st reading of the Vehicle Management Policy and that it be placed in the Legislative & Intergovernmental Affairs Committee. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Five in favor. One opposed. The motion carried.
10. Mr. Handelsman moved that the full Council review the Road Maintenance Policy. Seconded by Mr. Knight. Six in favor. The motion carried.
11. Mr. Edwards moved that 1st. reading of an Ordinance To Amend The Animal Control Ordinance be accepted as read. Seconded by Mr. Handelsman. Six in favor. The motion carried.
12. Mr. Weeks motioned to hire J.E.Serrine Co. to plan the renovations for the Courthouse & the Service Building. Seconded by Mr. Edwards. Mr. Wall amended that we go ahead and sign the contractual arrangements with J.E. Serrine. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Six in favor. The amendment carried.
13. Mr. Wall moved to rotate the meeting places on a 1 to 1 basis, St. George one time and Summerville next and so on. Seconded by Mr. Edwards. Mr. Handelsman amended to appoint an Ad Hoc Committee of 3 members consisting of the Chairman and one member from the eastern end of the County and one member from the Western end of the County and within a particular time frame come back and make some recommendations to the Council. Seconded by Knight. Roll call vote. In favor was Mr. Weeks, Mr. Knight, Mr. Handelsman and Mr. Waggoner. Opposed was Mr. Edwards, Mr. Wall and Mrs. Lang. The amendment carried the main motion.
14. Mr. Handelsman moved to recall the previous question on the Ad Hoc Committee. Seconded by Mr. Wall. Then Mr. Handelsman moved to table the question on the Ad Hoc Committee. Seconded by Mr. Wall. To table the motion carried.
15. Mr. Wall motioned that in Januray both meetings be held in St. George (Jan. 7 at 10AM & Jan. 21 at 7:30 PM), February in Summerville (Feb. 4 at 10AM & Feb. 18 at 7:30 PM), March in St. George (March 3 at 10AM & March 17 at 7:30 PM), April in Summerville (April 7 at 10 AM & April 21 at 7:30 PM), May in St. George (May 5 at 10AM & May 19 at 7:30 PM), June in

Seconded by Mr. Handelsman. Roll call vote. In favor was Mrs. Lang, Mr. Wall, Mr. Edwards and Mr. Handelsman. Opposed was Mr. Knight and Mr. Weeks. The motion carried.

16. Mr. Handelsman appointed Mr. Everett Knight to the Planning Commission Board and Ms. Cathy Derryberry to the Alcohol & Drug Abuse Commission. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Six in favor. The motion carried.

17. Mr. Knight appointed Mr. James Infinger to the Industrial Planning Commission and Mr. Lester McCurry to the Planning Commission Board. Seconded by Mr. Wall. Six in favor. The motion carried.

18. Mr. Knight moved to go into executive session to discuss Personnel Matters. Seconded by Mr. Weeks. Five in favor. One opposed. The Motion carried.

County Council reconvened into public session. Chairman Waggoner called the meeting back to order and stated that no action was taken in the executive session.

19. Mr. Weeks moved to give B-D EDC \$12,238.00. Seconded by Mr. Knight. Mr. Edwards amended to put it in the Finance Committee. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Roll call vote. In favor of the amendment was Mr. Edwards and Mrs. Lang. Opposed was Mr. Weeks, Mr. Knight, Mr. Handelsman and Mr. Wall. Amendment failed. Roll call vote on main motion. In favor was Mr. Weeks, Mr. Knight and Mr. Edwards. Mr. Handelsman opposed and Mr. Wall and Mrs. Lang passed. The motion carried.

FOR THE RECORD

Mr. Handelsman stated that as far as he was concerned he had not seen any real live substantiation that there really was a misinterpretation of the amounts of money that was budgeted. Also that the projected increase in the supplemental budget is not surplus money we underestimated the expenditures.

Mr. Wall asked Mr. Thomas Myers that in their conversations about how much money was budgeted did I (Mr. Wall) ever mislead you (Mr. Myers). Mr. Myers replied no.

Mr. Myers stated that we (his agency) have no inadequacy in our operation neither do we have any deficiency and we have established accountability. What we have is a breakdown of communications.

Mr. Handelsman stated that Council has never gotten an answer as to where this money is coming from also that Council must take this money from somebody else's pocket.

20. Mr. Edwards motioned to reconsider the vote to pay BDEDC the \$12,238. Seconded by Mr. Wall. Four in favor. Two opposed. The motion carried.

Dorchester County Council held a meeting January 21 in St. George at 7:30 P.M.

Members present: Chairman Kenneth Waggoner, Mr. Rollins Edwards, Mrs. Shirley Lang, Mr. Donald Handelsman, Mr. Wally Wall and Mr. Coke Weeks. The County Administrator Marc Hehn was present also.

Chairman Waggoner called the meeting to order and Revrend Gleaton gave the invocation.

1. Mr. Wall moved to accept the minutes of the January 1, 1980 Council Meeting. Seconded by Mr. Edwards. Five in favor. The motion carried.
2. County Council held a public hearing on the amended budget for F.Y. 1979-80. Chairman Waggoner asked for comments from the public. Mr. Danny DeToma spoke on behalf of the Old Fort Sertoma Club regarding financial support for their recreation programs. After some discussion and comments Chairman Waggoner closed the public hearing.
3. Ms. Linda Dukes appeared before Council on behalf of the citizens of Sprucewood Subdivision concerning the water & sewer problems. Mr. Wall motioned that a letter be sent to the Legislative Delegation, Public Service Commission, DHEC and the Attorney General expressing Council's concern about the problems with the water & sewer system in Sprucewood Subdivision and that any help from these sources would be appreciated. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Five in favor. The motion carried.
4. Mr. Edwards motioned to put into effect on a 6 month trial basis a solid waste collection plan. This plan would reduce the number of green waste box sites from 45 to 17 central locations. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Four in favor - one opposed. The motion carried.
5. Mr. Handelsman moved to accept the Roads in Pepperhill Subdivision. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Five in favor. The motion carried.
6. Mrs. Lang moved to purchase a smook alarm system for the St. George Jail. Seconded by Mr. Edwards. Four in favor - one not voting. The motion carried.

7. Mrs. Lang moved to approve \$3,318.00 for a bus for the Association of Retarded Citizens. Seconded by Mr. Handelsman. Five in favor. The motion carried.
8. Mr. Edwards moved to approve a request from the Department of Social Services for \$1,677.90 for indigent patient care. Seconded by Mr. Wall. Five in favor. The motion carried.
9. Mr. Handelsman moved to authorize the Administrator to take the steps necessary to finalize a purchase agreement for the Trolley Road Recreation Area. Seconded by Mr. Wall. Five in favor. The motion carried.
10. Mrs. Lang moved to go into executive session to receive legal advice. Seconded by Mr. Wall. Four in favor. The motion carried.
11. County Council reconvened into public session. Mr. Bell stated that in the executive session they discussed the 201 plan but that no formal action was taken. They also discussed the salary of an employee that had been reinstated but that no final determination had been made.
12. Mr. Handelsman moved to authorize the Chairman to negotiate contracts of acceptance between those wishing to deed their systems and those wishing to be bulk customers of Dorchester County System and the implementation date to be no later than January 1, 1981. Seconded by Mr. Wall. Five in favor. The motion carried.
13. Mr. Wall moved to accept the minutes of the 1-8-80 meeting of the Legislative & Intergovernmental Affairs Committee. Seconded by Mr. Edwards. Five in favor. The motion carried.
14. Mr. Wall moved to accept the minutes of the 1-17-80 meeting of the Legislative & Intergovernmental Affairs Committee as read. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Five in favor. The motion carried.
15. Mr. Wall moved that 1st reading be given to the Landfill Ordinance. by title only. Seconded by Mr. Handelsman. Four in favor. The motion carried.
16. Mr. Handelsman moved to accept 3rd reading of the personnel ordinance as amended. Seconded by Mr. Wall. Four in favor - 1 not voting. The motion carried.
17. Mr. Wall moved to give 2nd reading to the vehicle management policy. Seconded by Mr. Edwards. Five in favor. The motion carried.
18. Mr. Wall moved that 2nd reading be given to the encroachment permit Ordinance. Seconded by Mr. Handelsman. Five in favor. The motion carried.

Mr. Handelsman moved to give 3rd reading to the Dorchester County Supplemental Budget with the following amendments - line item 206.45 be reduced from \$8,000 to \$7,500, item 601.22 from \$4,000 to \$3,500, item 601.26 from \$17,850 to \$14,850, item 601.27 from \$4,000 to \$3,800, item 601.28 from \$4,000 to \$3,500, item 601.95 from \$4,000 to \$3,500, item 602.45 from \$24,000 to \$23,000, item 801.58 from \$8,000 to \$7,500, item 1101.89 from \$30,000 to \$25,000, and capital outlay for the County Fire Department to increase from \$30,000 to \$40,000 and add a Fire Study and appropriate \$6,500 to complete the study for the County and to 807.01 to increased by \$500.00. Seconded by Mr. Wall. Four in favor - one opposed. The motion carried.

22. Mr. Edwards moved to give 2nd reading to the amended animal control ordinance. Seconded by Mr. Wall. Five in favor. The motion carried.

23. Mr. Handelsman moved to accept resolution declaring the results of a special election on the sewer system. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Five in favor. The motion carried.

23. Mr. Wall moved to authorize the Administrator to pursue liquidated damages in reference to the County Libraries. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Five in favor. The motion carried.

25. Mr. Wall moved to pay Mrs. Cox \$4,092.17 and for it to be taken out of the contingency fund. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Five in favor. The motion carried.

26. Mr. Handelsman moved to adjourn. Seconded by Mr. Wall. All in favor. The motion carried.
