Dorchester County Council held a regular Meeting on January 12, 1981 at 7:30 P.M. in the Courtroom in St. George.

Members present were as follows: Mr. Kenneth Waggoner, Chairman, Mr. Donald Handelsman, Mr. Edmond Knight, Mr. George Knight, Mrs. Shirley Lang, Mr. Walter B. Wall and Mr. Coke Weeks. Mr. Marc Hehn, Administrator was present also.

Chairman Waggoner called the Meeting to order and welcomed the guests. Mr. Hehn gave the invocation.

 Mr. Weeks moved to accept the minutes of the December 15, 1980 Meeting of County Council. Seconded by Mr. George Knight. All members voted in favor. The motion carried.

Judge John H. Smith held the swearing in ceremony. Those being sworn in were Mr. Edmond Knight, Mrs. Shirley Lang, Mr. Wally Wall, Mr. Carl Knight, Mr. Shelton Parker and Mr. Robbie Clayton.

Mr. Edmond Knight the newly elected member of County Council was elected for a term of 4 years.

- 2. Mr. Handelsman moved to reconfirm Mr. Waggoner as Chairman of Dorchester County Council. Seconded by Mr. Wall. Six voted in favor. The motion carried.
- 3. Mr. Handelsman moved to nominate Mr. Walter B. Wall, Jr. as Vice-chairman of Dorchester County Council. Seconded by Mrs. Lang. Two voted in favor, one opposed and two did not vote. The motion carried.
- Mr. Handelsman moved that we put it in the Finance Committee (funds for ARC). Seconded by Mr. Wall. All voted in favor. The motion carried.

A public hearing was held on the amendments to the Subdivision Regulations. Chairman Waggoner asked for comments from the public. After no response from the public, Chairman Waggoner closed the hearing.

Chairman Waggoner called the Meeting to order and welcomed the guest. Mr. Jakle Walters gave the invocation.

- 5. Mr. Handelsman motioned that Mr. Judy work with Mr. Thomas and come up with an alternative to use the concrete ramps at the Services Building in Summerville. Seconded by Mr. Wall. All were in favor. The motion carried.



DORCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL COURTHOUSE - ST. GEORGE JULY 6, 1981 7:30 P.M.

Dorchester County Council held a meeting on July 5, 1981, at 7:30 P.M. in the Dorchester County Courthouse in St. George.

Hembers present were as follows: Mr. Kenneth F. Waggoner, Chairman, Mr. Donald Handelsman, Mr. Edmond Knight, Mr. George Knight, Mrs. Shirley Lang, Mr. Wally Wall, and Mr. Coke Weeks. Mr. Marc Hehn, County Administrator, was also present.

Chairman Waggoner called the meeting to order and $\mbox{\rm Mr.}$ Walters gave the invocation.

- 1. A Public Hearing was held concerning 3rd reading of the General Obligation Bond Ordinance. There were no comments.
- 2. Mr. Handelsman moved to give 1st reading to an Ordinance regulating the discharge of firearms. Seconded by Mr. Knight with the provision that the Ordinance be placed in the Legislative and Inter-governmental Committee for further study. All voted in favor and the motion carried.
- 3. Mr. George Knight moved to go into executive session to discuss personnel matters. The motion was seconded by Mr. Edmond Knight. All voted in favor and the motion carried.

No action was taken in executive session.

4. Mr. Handelsman moved to accept the list of roads into the County that were recommended by Mr. Jim Drawdy. The motion was seconded by Mr. Wall. There was no discussion, all voted in favor and the motion carried.

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5. Mr. George Knight moved to reorganize the Public Works Department as follows:

Road Maintenance-Vehicle Maintenance Center, Landfill and Waste Collection be combined, and under the supervision of Road Maintenance Supervisor, J. D. Wagers, thereby deleting the Maintenance Center Foreman, James Mitchell. The Road Maintenance Supervisor will report directly to the Administrator. Mr. Jim Drawdy will be the foreman of the Landfill and Solid Waste and report to the Administrator and that the Building Maintenance Foreman, Mr. Clevie Chinners, report directly to the Administrator.

The Director of Planning, Mr. Jack Langston, be made the Director of Planning and the Sewer Project - the sign-up, the coordination of the engineers and county government and whatever else is needed to get this program moving, and that Mrs. Norma Patrick, Secretary in Road Maintenance, be shifted to this department. The Department Head, Mr. Jack Langston, will report to the County Administrator.

It is proposed that these changes take effect immediately and that all department heads will assume their authority as of department opening time, July 7, 1981.

Those persons whose positions have been deleted will be advised verbally immediately by the County Administrator and as soon as possible in writing by the County Administrator. These persons will be given whatever compensation is due according to the County Personnel Manuel concerning persons who become unemployed due to reorganization.


The motion was seconded by Mr. Edmond Knight. A roll call vote was taken, five voted in favor and one opposed. The motion carried.




