I, the APPLICANT, understand and agree to the following procedures to be utilized for this applicant:

1. One hundred percent (100%) of the development's infrastructure and seventyfive percent (75%) of the development's structural (lots) "build-out" must be completed prior to the completion of this application.

2. The roads being considered for county maintenance acceptance must receive an initial inspection and favorable recommendation by the County Public Works Director. Any cost involved to bring these roads into compliance will be borne by the applicant. (This may involve cost to core sample the road.)

3. The County Planning Department must review and recommend approval of the application. (A recorded plat must be submitted, 11x17 acceptable if legible).

4. The County Council approval date will be the "Start Date" of the twelve (12) "Maintenance Liability Period." The applicant will bear the expense to maintain the subject roads/streets and drainage system during this period.

5. Upon the completion of the Maintenance Liability Period, the APPLICANT will request the Public Works Director for a "Final 'Acceptance' Inspection." Any noted defects (abnormal wear and tear) must be repaired by the applicant within ninety (90) days of the inspection, or the whole process may start over.

6. Upon favorable "Final 'Acceptance' Inspection" results, the Public Works Director will write a "Release of Liability," letter to the applicant within thirty (30) days.

7. Major Roads serving several subdivisions may require additional design criteria at the discretion of the Public Works Director and will require minimum "Maintenance Liability Period," of twelve (12) months.
