**AN ORDINANCE, AMENDING THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, DORCHESTER COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA, BY REVISING ARTICLE V, CONVENIENCE SITES, SECTION 34-132 (c), CONVENIENCE SITES**

WHEREAS, Dorchester County is empowered to adopt ordinances as may appear to be necessary and proper for the security, general welfare and convenience of the public and for preserving health, peace, order and good government; and

WHEREAS, Dorchester County Council has determined there is a need to establish a set of rules for use of Convenience Sites for the welfare of its citizens;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the Dorchester County Council, duly assembled, that the Code of Ordinances, Dorchester County, South Carolina, is hereby amended by revising Article V, Convenience Sites, Section 34-132 (c), as follows:

**ARTICLE V. - CONVENIENCE SITES**

Sec. 34-132. - Convenience Sites

- (c) The use of vehicles larger than a 1 ton pick-up, or trailers larger than a single-axle, shall be prohibited at County convenience sites.

Should any section, paragraph, or provision of this section be adjudged invalid or held unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such declaration shall not affect the validity of this article as a whole or any part or provisions thereof, other than the part or provisions so decided to be invalid or unconstitutional.

This Ordinance shall be effective upon 3<sup>rd</sup> and final reading.
