**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND AND SUPPLEMENT THE CODE OF ORDINANCES,
DORCHESTER COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA, CHAPTER 44, ARTICLE III, SEC. 44-106.
BY ADDING A NEW SUBSECTION (6) ALLOWING THE TRANSFER OF PAST DUE
ACCOUNTS TO ANY OTHER ACCOUNT OF THE SAME CUSTOMER OR FINANCIALLY
RESPONSIBLE PERSON AND BY AMENDING SEC. 44-112 BY THE DELETION OF THE
WORD "WORKING"**

It is hereby Ordained by Dorchester County Council, duly assembled, that the Code of Ordinances, Dorchester County, South Carolina, is hereby amended and supplemented as follows:

Chapter 44, Article III, Sec. 44-106 is supplemented by the addition of a new subsection (6) which shall read as follows:

(6) When an account has past-due charges that have existed for sixty (60) days or more, those past-due charges may be transferred to any other account of the same customer or financially responsible person. Should the account remain unpaid, normal nonpayment procedures will be followed.

Chapter 44, Article III, Sec. 44-112 is amended by the deletion of the word "working".

Except as amended and supplemented hereby, the Code of Ordinances, Dorchester County, South Carolina shall remain in full force and effect.
