Community Needs Assessment Public Hearing and Fair Housing Month

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on **April 17, 2023 at 6:00 PM**, Dorchester County will hold a public hearing at the Dorchester County Human Services building, 500 North Main Street, Summerville, SC 29483. The purpose of the public hearing is to solicit public input on community needs for housing, public facilities, economic development and other identified priorities to serve low-moderate income households. At this public hearing, Dorchester County will present results in its draft needs assessment and the activities which might be undertaken to meet identified needs, including the estimated amounts available to be used for activities that will benefit persons of low and moderate income.

At the same meeting, Dorchester County Council will consider a resolution proclaiming April 2023 as Fair Housing Month. Fair Housing Month recognizes the SC Fair Housing Law enacted in 1989 banning housing providers (managers, sellers, and landlords) from discriminating actions in the sale, rental, or provision of other housing services on the basis of race, religion, color, sex, national origin, disability, and/or familial status.

This public hearing and the matters to be discussed are subject to the provisions of the Dorchester County Citizen Participation Plan. The Plan was developed in anticipation of participation in the State of South Carolina's Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program, providing for the participation of the citizens of Dorchester County in the planning and implementation of community and economic development projects which will involve CDBG funds.
