NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Dorchester County Council hereby proclaims May 2024, Hurricane Preparedness Month "Make the most of your time while you still have it" throughout Dorchester County and urges everyone to join Dorchester County Emergency Management, the National Weather Service, and other agencies across the state in their efforts to encourage and foster hurricane preparedness during the month of May and throughout the entire hurricane season.
