WHEREAS, the Regional Workforce Snapshot Q2 2024 reports there were 430,698 people employed in the Trident Region with an unemployment rate of 3.9%; and

WHEREAS, challenges for potential workforce are exacerbated by barriers to employment including transportation, housing, and childcare; and

WHEREAS, collaboration among the federal, state, and local government leaders along with state and local education, human service agencies, local businesses, employment service providers, community-based organizations, and workforce development boards must take place to achieve long-term, sustainable, and successful workforce development across traditional, high-need sectors and emerging industries; and
