AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND DORCHESTER COUNTY ZONING AND LAND DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS ORDINANCE NUMBER 04-13, AS PREVIOUSLY AMENDED, WITH RESPECT TO ARTICLE V, SECTION 5.6.1.2 TO CHANGE THE TIME PERIOD FROM ONE YEAR TO TWO YEARS AND WITH RESPECT TO ARTICLE XIV, SECTION 14.3.2 TO AUTHORIZE THE CONFISCATION AND DISPOSAL OF ILLEGAL SIGNAGE.

WHEREAS, Dorchester County Council desires to amend Dorchester County Zoning and Land Development Standards Ordinance Number 04-13, as heretofore amended, as set forth below.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by Dorchester County Council, duly assembled, that Dorchester County Zoning and Land Development Standards Ordinance Number 04-13, as previously amended, is further amended as follows:

- 1. Article V, Section 5.6.1.2 is amended to change the words "one (1) year" to "two (2) years".
- 2. Article XIV, Section 14.3.2(h) is amended to delete the word "and" at the end of that subsection.
- 3. Article XIV, Section 14.3.2(i) is amended to add the words "including confiscation and disposal of illegal signage" at the end of that subsection.
- 4. Article XIV, Section 14.3.2 is amended to add a new subsection to read as follows: "(j) confiscate and dispose of any illegal signage placed on public property, which shall be considered forfeited to the public."

Except as specifically amended hereby, Dorchester County Zoning and Land Development Standards Ordinance Number 04-13, as heretofore amended, and as amended hereby, shall remain in full force and effect.
