RESOLUTION SUPPORTING THE APPLICATION FOR 50/50 MATCHING FUNDS FROM THE SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FISCAL YEAR 2013 FEDERAL RESURFACING MATCH PROGRAM FOR RESURFACING US 78 PHASE 3

WHEREAS, the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) is administering the Fiscal Year 2013 Federal Resurfacing Match Program that can fund on a 50/50 matching basis eligible highway resurfacing projects,

WHEREAS, the Dorchester County Sales Tax Transportation Authority (DCTA) is in the final stages of qualifying US 78 Phase 3 Resurfacing,

WHEREAS, the project is estimated to cost \$2,390,000, thus making the project potentially eligible for an \$1,195,000 grant from the Fiscal Year 2013 Federal Resurfacing Match Program, and


WHEREAS, Dorchester County Council recognizes the importance of US 78 Phase 3 Resurfacing to enhance public safety and provide pavement preservation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that Dorchester County Council endorses and authorizes the DCTA to apply for a grant from the Fiscal Year 2013 Federal Resurfacing Match Program to cover 50 percent of US 78 Phase 3 Resurfacing.


