
AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, DORCHESTER COUNTY, SOUTH CAROLINA, TO AMEND CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE III, DIVISION 2. SEC. 2-98 (c) (4) a. TO DELETE CERTAIN LANGUAGE DEALING WITH PLACING ITEMS ON THE COUNTY COUNCIL AGENDA AND SUBSTITUTE NEW LANGUAGE IN LIEU THEREOF

WHEREAS, Dorchester County Council wishes to amend the Code of Ordinances, Dorchester County, South Carolina, to amend language dealing with placing items on the County Council Agenda.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it ordained by Dorchester County Council, duly assembled, that the sentence reading "This requirement may be waived by the Administrator or Chairman in cases of great urgency if the matter is presented in writing and every member of Council is informed prior to the commencement of the meeting, or as otherwise specified in the Agenda." as contained in Chapter 2, Article III, Division 2. Sec. 2-98 (c) (4) a. is hereby deleted and the following sentence is substituted in lieu thereof: "This requirement may be waived by the Administrator or Chairman in cases of great urgency, so long as the matter is specified in the Agenda."

Except as specifically amended herein, the Dorchester County Code of Ordinances shall remain in full force and effect.


