WHEREAS, Mr. Sarine drove the ambulance to the hospital so that Mr. Varnadoe and Ms. Rowell could keep the hypothermic patient alive by providing artificial ventilations, warming her, and constantly stimulating her to breathe; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Sarine went above and beyond the call of duty, and his action allowed EMS to provide life saving treatment, without which the patient may have suffered brain injury or death; and

WHEREAS, Dorchester County Council is pleased to honor and recognize Mr. Chris Sarine's brave and selfless action in saving the life of a child, and Mr. Kevin Varnadoe and Ms. Liz Rowell for their extraordinary patient care.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that upon adoption of this Resolution, the original shall be presented to Mr. Chris Sarine, Mr. Kevin Varnadoe, and Ms. Liz Rowell. Additionally, a copy will be filed in the permanent records of Dorchester County, South Carolina.
