A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE OLD FORT DRIVE EXTENSION BE NAMED WALLACE ACKERMAN DRIVE

WHEREAS, Wallace "Ack" Ackerman was born on January 28, 1920, in Cottageville, SC, and was a resident of Kings Grant, Summerville, SC, when he passed away on January 25, 2010; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ackerman was a proud alumnus of Clemson University, Class of 1941, and served in the United States Army Air Corp as a 1st Lieutenant during World War II before working 40 years at MeadWestvaco as a chemical engineer; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ackerman was an active member in the Kiwanis Club, served on the Dorchester County Sales Tax Transportation Authority as its Vice Chairman, was a Dorchester County Election Commission Poll Manager and was also a Dorchester County Councilman; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Ackerman was an avid volunteer for civic and political projects, a 32nd degree Mason and a member of Stallsville United Methodist Church for 36 years, serving in several positions within the church; and

WHEREAS, Dorchester County Council wishes to honor the memory of the late Mr. Wallace Ackerman for his years of service to the citizens of Dorchester County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Dorchester County Council requests that the Dorchester County Legislative Delegation introduces a Resolution to name the Old Fort Drive Extension "Wallace Ackerman Drive," beginning at Old Fort Drive and Recess Drive and ending at Ladson Road, once this road is accepted by the South Carolina Department of Transportation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon adoption of this Resolution, the original shall be filed in the permanent records of Dorchester County, South Carolina, and a copy shall be forwarded to the South Carolina Department of Transportation.
