ORDINANCE NUMBER 97-13

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND DORCHESTER COUNTY ORDINANCE NUMBER 83-05, PROCUREMENT MANUAL, PART C - DEALING WITH THE PROCUREMENT APPEALS BOARD.

WHEREAS, Ordinance Number 83-05 established a procedure for purchasing and procurement for Dorchester County;

AND WHEREAS, Part C created a Procurement Appeals Board and established its term of office;

AND WHEREAS, Dorchester County Council is desirous of amending that portion of the Procurement Ordinance dealing with the term of office of the Procurement Appeals board;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE DORCHESTER COUNTY COUNCIL, that Part C - Procurement Appeals Board, Section 7-301(1), is hereby deleted in its entirety and the following is substituted in lieu thereof:

Section 7-301(1) Term

The term of office of the members of the Procurement Appeals Board shall be for a term of four (4) years. This term of office shall commence upon appointment by a member. Each member of County Council shall be responsible for making one appointment to the Procurement Appeals Board.


EFFECTIVE DATE

The provisions of this ordinance shall become effective upon the third reading.
